MONTHLY TUITION RATES

TUITION IS BASED ON TOTAL HOURS OF CLASS TAKEN PER STUDENT, PER WEEK. TUITION WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE DEBITED USING THE CARD ON FILE ON THE 1ST OF EACH MONTH AND IS CONSIDERED LATE IF IT IS NOT PAID BY THE 5TH. A LATE OF \$25 WILL BE APPLIED TO ALL ACCOUNTS WITH A BALANCE PAST THE 5TH OF EACH MONTH.

FAMILY TUITION CAP:

FAMILIES WITH MULTIPLE DANCERS WILL NEVER PAY MORE THAN \$330/MONTH IN TUITION, REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER OF CLASSES TAKEN. THIS CAP DOES NOT INCLUDE REGISTRATION, COSTUME, OR RECITAL FEES.

- SIBLINGS RECEIVE A 10% DISCOUNT, IF YOU DO NOT MEET OUR FAMILY TUITION CAP THEN YOU WILL BE GIVEN A 10% DISCOUNT FOR EVERY ADDITIONAL SIBLING

TUITION CAPS AT 8 CLASSES:

DANCERS ENROLLED IN 8 OR MORE CLASSES PER WEEK PAY NO MORE THAN \$235/MONTH
